About our camp

Spring Creek and The Children's Workshop employs teachers that are state certified and/or director qualified in early childhood education. They are required to be certified in both CPR and First Aid. We maintain at all times the state-mandated student to child ratios. For field trips we increase the number of staff if we feel the event warrants it. Class counts are taken anytime the children move from one location to another.

Our camp participates in the Child and Adult Care Food Program. This means that your child will receive nutritious meals when at camp. If you would like a copy of the camp menu, please see your child's director.

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What to bring to camp:

Campers will be assigned a cubby to store belongings at the center. These are not secure, so do not bring important or valuable items to camp. NO GAMEBOYS, IPODS, OR OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES WILL BE ALLOWED.

Campers should check the Event Calendar for needed items depending on the activity planned; swimsuits, money, supplies, and towels, etc. A water bottle or canteen that can be hooked on a belt or carried in a backpack should be brought everyday.

Skates, bikes and roller blades are occasionally needed. Please check your calendar. Helmets are encouraged. Campers should bring one change of clothes to keep in their cubby/locker for the extent of summer camp.

All personal items should be labeled with your child's name and phone number. Non-essential items should be left at home. Spring Creek & The Children's Workshop Summer Camps are not responsible for lost or damaged personal items.

Our camp policy regarding weather is as follows: the children will not be permitted outside when the temperature exceeds 95 degrees. With warmer weather it is a good idea to switch out any spare clothing in your child's locker. A hat is a great way to shade your child from the sun. Be sure to label your child's hat with a permanent marker.
